Tobi Adebajo is a versatile and pioneering figure in the creative sphere, embracing various roles as an anti-disciplinary artist, writer, and birth and death doula. From exploring the realities of existing as a Black, Queer, Trans, Disabled person, to creating unique audio-visual pieces, Tobi aims to elicit curated reactions from the viewer. Utilising artistic mediums like sound, movement, visual and written pieces, their practice draws from all the senses and relies upon meaningful collaboration to create work centralising diasporic experiences. They present evidence of communal and spiritual languages that we possess but may be unable to access, framing this language as a basis for collective healing and liberation.
